INVITATION FOR TENDERS

Water and Wastewater Development Project for the Municipality of Nevesinje

Municipality Of Nevesinje

The Municipality Of Nevesinje (hereinafter referred to as “the Borrower”) has received a loan from the European Investment Bank – EIB (hereinafter referred to as “the Bank”) – towards the cost of the Water and Wastewater Development Project for the Municipality Of Nevesinje. This International Invitation for Tenders relates to the contract for Rehabilitation of Alagovac Water Treatment Plant.

This contract will be based on FIDIC Yellow Book Conditions of Contract and include:

- Test all existing electro-mechanical equipment, pipelines and fittings which will stay in operation after completion of this contract. Provide testing report with recommendation on which equipment has to be replaced. Agree additional works in this respect with the Employer and Engineer.
- Salvage the existing electro-mechanical equipment as required by the Employer’s Requirements.
- Refurbish and test all existing structures as required by the Employer’s Requirements
- Design, build, test and commission WTP to meet the criteria specified in the Employer’s Requirements and incorporate existing refurbished structures and some of the existing electro-mechanical equipment.

The works on WTP rehabilitation shall be executed on the Design & Build basis comprising P&DB Conditions of Contract (FIDIC Yellow Book, Edition 1999) and include rehabilitation of following structures and equipment:

- (1) Raw water Pumping Station
- (2) Clear water Pumping Station
- (3) Clarifier unit
- (4) Filter units
- (5) Backwash water Pumping Station
- (6) Operating building with treated water reservoir – roof reconstruction

The criteria to be used in the tender evaluation are, in decreasing order of importance:

Award Criteria

- the lowest evaluated Tender price.

Technical and Professional Capacity

a. Successful experience (Final Acceptance issued) as a prime contractor in construction of at least two contracts during the last 8 years including:

- 1 project with a minimum value of 2 million Euro in water treatment works;
- 1 design-build project with a minimum value of 1 million Euro performed under Yellow Book FIDIC Conditions of Contract.

b. Successful experience as a main designer (himself or a nominated design consultant) of at least 2 projects during the last 8 years including:

- 1 project of similar nature and complexity with the value of designed works of minimum 2 million Euro;
- 1 project of similar nature and complexity with the value of designed works of 1 million Euro;

Economic and Financial Capacity

The average annual turnover of the tenderer in the last 3 years must be at least 4 million Euro equivalent.

The Tenderer shall demonstrate, by a bank statement from his bank, that he has available or he has access to, liquid assets, lines of credit, or other financial means sufficient to meet the construction cash flow for the contract, not less than one half (0.5) million Euro equivalent, for a period of 6 months, in addition to the Tenderer's commitments for other contracts.

An obligatory pre-tender meeting, incl. site visit, is envisaged to take place on July 11, 2017 at the address above.

Eligible bidders

The EIB shall not provide finance, directly or indirectly, to or for the benefit of, award a contract under any EIB Project to, or enter into any relationship with, an individual or entity who is subject to financial sanctions imposed by the European Union pursuant to Chapter 2 of Title V of the Treaty on European Union or article 215 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, either autonomously or pursuant to the financial sanctions decided by the United Nations Security Council on the basis of article 41 of the UN Charter. This applies without the need for the Exclusion Proceedings.

Other than that all firms are invited to participate in the tender.
